The Bundaberg Primary School's Athletics Carnival is fast approaching. The dates are as follows:

Thursday 10 August	- 200m, long jump, high jump, shot put, discus and 800m heats at St Luke's Anglican School.
Friday 11 August	- Sprints, relays, ball games and 800m final at St Luke's Anglican School.
Friday 18 August	- 1500m trials St Luke's Anglican School. 9.30am
Thursday 30 August	- Wide Bay Regional 10-12 Years Athletics at Bundaberg

It would be greatly appreciated if you would allow the release of your school's physical education teacher for these days. These activities are part of the duties of the P.E. Teacher and to make these days run successfully, we need the P.E. teachers to help officiate with a variety of jobs on these days. Regional TRS is not available for the above days, but it is hoped that the P.E. teachers will be released to carry out duties on these days.

Following is information relating to our 2 days of events. A checklist of what is enclosed is attached. Please check all sheets and data are enclosed. If any are missing, please contact me as above.

It would be greatly appreciated if this information, especially job rosters and nomination forms were **passed onto the relevant staff at your school**. It would also be greatly appreciated if the required forms were returned to me by the appropriate date.

The 2023 Bundaberg and District Primary Schools' Athletic Carnival will be held at St Luke's Anglican School on Friday 11 August. Preceding this day Long Jump, Shot Put, High Jump, Discus, 200m and 800m events will be contested at St Luke's Anglican School on Thursday 10 August.

**DAY 1:** On Thursday 10 August LONG JUMP, SHOT PUT, HIGH JUMP, DISCUS, 200m and 800m events will be held at St Luke's Anglican School. This year it is of the utmost importance that we begin this day at **8:55 am** sharp. The program has changed totally to previous years. Schools, please, organise transport arrangements (possibly private transport is an option) so that competitors in the 1<sup>st</sup> round of events can be **marshaled at 8:40am**.

A tuckshop will be open at St Luke's Anglican School where children may purchase food and drinks. Information on its location, items for sale and costs are on an attached page. A diagram indicating locations of event areas, toilets, entrances and parking facilities is also attached.

Day 2: Friday 11 August. The program is as in past years.

#### **DAY 1 OFFICIALS**

- Please ensure nominated children **CAN** jump the qualifying height.
- No more than two (2) nominations per school per age group.

It is expected that most children will use the Scissor Jump technique. The Fosbury Flop technique may be used by children 10 years and over who have had **adequate lead-up activities conducted by a teacher/coach with competence in teaching the event.** It is a high-risk activity therefore the Health and Safety Guidelines for Athletics – Jumping Events should be followed. (See attached)

## Discus - QUALIFYING DISTANCES

- Please ensure nominated children <u>CAN</u> throw the qualifying distance. This is not a come and try event.
- No more than two (2) nominations per school per age group.
- It is a high-risk activity therefore the Health and Safety Guidelines for Athletics. (See attached)

Some of the 800m events may start earlier than the set start. This will be as an age group finishes their event from previous round they may be called to get ready for their 800m race.

## **CARNIVAL GUIDELINES**

Please observe the following carnival guidelines regarding the wearing of SPIKES.

## LONG JUMP

For safety reasons it is suggested that children wear shoes when competing in Long Jump. Spikes may be worn provided that:

- 1. Competitors remove spikes immediately after coming out of the pit and carry them by hand back to a special area.
- 2. Competitors who intend to wear spikes must remain in the special area until they are called up by officials.

## 200 METRES

Spikes will be allowed provided that each competitor carries the spikes to the allocated lane. Once in that lane, the competitor will put the spikes on. When the race is finished spikes must be removed as soon as possible while the athlete remains in the allocated lane. Spikes will then be carried by hand.

#### 800 METRES

NO SPIKES ARE PERMITTED

## **WARNING**

Any teacher who sees a child wearing spikes, not in the special long jump area, or a 200 metre lane, should tell the child to remove the spikes immediately. Competitors who fail to comply with these conditions may be removed from the competition.

## STARTING

Teachers should train children to put the foot up to the ribbon on the starting line not on it or over it.

#### **OUT OF BOUNDS**

No children or spectators are permitted inside the 400m track unless marshalling for 200m or 800m events.




