

Term 1 - Football

Match Results

a) The following points will be awarded for matches during the Regular Season:

- Win = 3 points
- Draw = 1 point
- Loss = 0 points
- Bye = 3 points
- Forfeit = - 1 point

Duration of Matches

- a) In all matches, the following match duration will be played: two halves of 20 minutes each.
- b) The half-time interval is to be of 5mins duration.
- c) The referee has the right to abandon any match if, in his/her opinion, playing conditions compromise player safety.

Referees

Typically, the coaches of the two teams will referee a half each unless alternative arrangements are made but both coaches have to agree upon if, it is to be a student refereeing.

First Aid

Each team and coach will be responsible for their own players first aid concerns.

Substitution of Players

For all divisions, unlimited interchange will be permitted, A maximum number of 20 players can participate in any match in a team.

Forfeits

- a) Should a team forfeit a match prior to kick-off, the opposing team shall be awarded the full points (3) and be deemed to have won the match by a score of three (3) goals to nil (0). The team which has forfeited shall be awarded -1 point.
- b) Should a team forfeit after a match has commenced, the opposing team shall be awarded the full points and be deemed to have won the match by a score of three (3) goals to nil (0), or the actual goal difference, whichever is the greater.

FINALS SERIES DETAILS

OPEN BOYS – Only 2 x teams in the competition. Schools (Shalom and SLAS) are to negotiate how many and when their games are to be played.

OPEN GIRLS & INTERMEDIATE BOYS – 6 x round robin games with top 2 teams progressing to finals day.

JUNIOR BOYS – Semi Finals will be held in week 6 (1v4 and 2v3) with the winners of each match progressing to Finals Day.

Where team points are equal at the end of the round robin matches, goal difference will be used to determine final placings.
