RESPONSIBILITIES AS A BUNDABERG DISTRICT COACH/OFFICIAL (GUIDELINES BASED ON WBSS)

Obtain your school principal's approval prior to the acceptance of the position as an official;
Complete a Risk Assessment (CARA) for your trial;
Inform your school and the BDSSS 13-19yrs Secretary of your absence from school during the trials in order to claim for TRS or associated relief;
Arrange appropriate training prior to the trials, if required;
Arrange, with other coaches and staff members, selection trials and venues;
Notify the BDSSS 13-19yrs Secretary of Bundaberg trial information;
At the conclusion of the trials hand to all successful players their letter of congratulations and parental/medical information sheets. <i>Avoid having Sports Coordinators pass this information on to students if possible.</i>
Complete the Team Notification form and pass on details to the BDSSS 13-19yrs Secretary $\underline{\textbf{WITHIN}}$ $\underline{\textbf{2 DAYS}}$ OF BDSSS 13-19yrs TRIALS ;
Complete F10 & F11 forms and send to all relevant schools WITHIN 2 DAYS OF BDSSS TRIALS ;
 Ensure selected Bundaberg team members are informed about: Appropriate dress - remember students must travel to Wide Bay trials in their own schools sport uniform. Wide Bay trial/ bus levy – this must be payed to their own school Travel times, bus departure venue and Wide Bay trial venues This can all be achieved through the distribution of a player notification letter given to students at the Bundaberg trials once they are selected in the Bundaberg District Team
Contact the school in-charge of the district uniform (currently St Luke's) to arrange the distribution of the uniform to students;
Arrange for all necessary equipment including first aid kits to be at trainings and trials;
Complete the Wide Bay Selections Nomination Form for the selectors prior to the trials for the students competing for Bundaberg District;
Collect all Parent Consent and Team Member Code of Behaviour forms from students prior to travel;
Confirm with the BDSSS 13-19yrs Secretary the students that ACTUALLY attended Wide Bay trials and their schools – <u>WITHIN 2 DAYS</u> OF WIDE BAY TRIALS; and
REMAIN with students and in position of <i>'loco parentis'</i> of team members upon return from Wide Bay Trials until all students are collected.
Complete the Wide Bay Representative Selection form and send to the BDSSS 13-19yrs Secretary – WITHIN 2 DAYS OF WIDE BAY TRIALS.

Remember as coach you must provide all players with the best opportunity for selection and allow them to demonstrate their abilities at the Wide Bay trials fairly with the policy of equal time for all players being adhered to. The following are maximum team numbers for all sports at Wide Bay and if possible coaches are to fill all positions.

You are **not** obliged to take the maximum number to Wide Bay Trials, but you cannot exceed the maximum number.

"Those students selected to represent the Region at State level must be given a fair and reasonable amount of participation in games conducted at the State Championships."

Responsibilities of the coach as a selector:

In consultation with the Bundaberg District Trial Convenor arrange a suitable time, venue, equipment and referees required for the Bundaberg District selection trials (preferably the same as the other divisions of a similar sport);
Notify the District Secretary of the selection trials details as soon as possible after your appointment as a Bundaberg Coach;
Allow for adequate time to give all students a fair trial and have a wet weather plan;
Negotiate to have at least ONE other staff member from other schools to be present at the selection trials to assist you in the roles as selectors. Where possible, avoid using parents and club personnel as selectors. PLEASE NOTE : TRIALS SHOULD NOT PROCEED IF TWO SELECTORS (coach plus one other) ARE NOT PRESENT – TRIALS SHOULD BE RE-SCHEDULED.
Selection criteria shall be based on the WBSS selection policy. Areas considered shall include: o the level of skills exhibited by the student, o the performance of the student as a member of a team, o the attitude and behaviour of the student on and off the field of competition, o the age of the student, and o the attendance of an affiliated school within the Bundaberg District with the following exception: - A student/s from another Wide Bay School Sport affiliated district may participate in Bundaberg sports trials for selection in a Bundaberg team for Wide Bay trials, when that affiliated district does not have its own team in that sport participating in Wide Bay trials. This is restricted to sports that compete on a team basis. In this circumstance, the sports coordinator (or proxy) from the school involved is to contact the relevant BDSS coach in advance of the trials to inform him/her of this situation.
Players who are participating for another representative sport at the time of the trials may be considered for selection, provided written application, supported by their Principal, has been submitted to the BDSSS association and/or the district coach (based on WBSS policy).
A student who has an approved absence (eg illness, injury, family bereavement) at the time of the trials, may be considered for selection in the district team, provided that appropriate documentation or evidence is submitted to the district coach (based on WBSS policy).
Selectors must be seen to provide all students a fair opportunity to demonstrate their ability in the selections trials. Game formats are normally used to identify the student's understanding and ability of the game, followed by possibles/probables scenarios. Some sports will require outside proof of player's ability eg golf handicaps at the record cards;
All members selected to represent the Bundaberg team must be informed (including shadows if necessary), by way of written confirmation immediately following the final selection trials. Avoid sending letters and forms to schools to distribute to players. (See example of the player's notification letter).

Remember selectors are to choose the best players and to be fair and equal in their judgements of player's abilities. Players must therefore perform well at the trials before they can be eligible.

STUDENTS UNABLE TO ATTEND BUNDABERG TRIALS

Students unable to attend BDSSS 13-19yrs trials should make the Bundaberg Coach aware of this either directly or through their own school's Sports Coordinator. If the student is to be considered for BDSS team selection, the Bundaberg Coach must be aware that the student is unable to trial BEFORE the trials commence. Once trials commence (and particularly after the BDSS team is announced) there will be no further consideration of students for teams.

Students who are unable to attend BDSSS trials should:

- See their own school's sport coordinator to get an 'unable to attend trials' form.
- Complete the form including reason for non-participation at trials and a player profile section to assist in selector decisions.
- Return the form to the school sport coordinator or the BDSSS coach within the timelines indicated on the form (see guidelines identified on form below):

Where at all possible students should make arrangements to participate in Bundaberg Trials; including rescheduling appointments or work commitments. Students should understand that failure to attend trials may, in some cases, disadvantage them in the selection process. If students are unable to attend trials or are unable to participate due to injury or illness please ensure you:

- · Complete this section of the form
- Return this form (including a medical/ permission form) to your school's Sports Coordinator or the Bundaberg Coach.

Forms must be handed to your school's Sport Coordinator early on (or before) the day of Bundaberg trials in order to allow time for the Sports Coordinator to pass on your details to the Selectors **BEFORE** trials. Alternatively, this form can be given directly to the Bundaberg District Coach or delivered to selectors at the Trial venue **prior to the commencement** of Bundaberg trials. In all cases the Bundaberg Coach, Manager or Selectors **MUST** receive information about students who are unable to participate in Bundaberg Trials **prior to the commencement** of those trials if students are to be considered in the selection process.
